- **Business academy** (63-41-M/004)
- **Business lyceum** (78-42-M/002)
- **Enterprise** (64-41-L/524)

Curriculum of the Business Academy Branch is focused on

- **Tourism** (a four-year full time course)
- **Information and communication technology** (a four-year full time course)

Students are taught to analyse structure of travel agencies making itinerary and services connected with transport, accomodation, catering, organizing sightseeing tours and trips to popular domestic and European destinations as well as giving presentation . Thanks to ICT programmes our graduates assert themselves in jobs such as economist, accountant, assistent, personal officer, manager, travel guide or IT specialist.

A great emphasis has always been placed on foreign languages as we prefer English, German and Russian.

Curriculum of the Business Lyceum Branch (a four-year full time course) is based on

a wider generally educational foundation. The inevitable part of it is professional education to business – oriented subjects and key knowledge making a profile of business university studies.

A good portion of graduates are also admitted to further studies.

We offer :

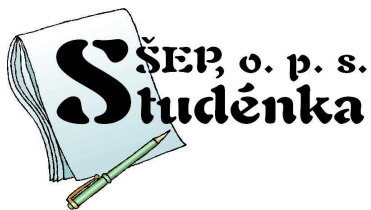
- high quality equipment of the information and communication technology
